

University Summer Courses offered in Germany for Foreign Students and Graduates (Hochschulsommerkurse) HSK – 2021-2022

Regular full-time students registered in a Bachelor or Master degree programme from any subject field, having at least B1 level of German language proficiency as per the CEFR (onSET-Deutsch, TestDaF, Goethe Institut - Nachweis, DSD, DSH, telc Deutsch, ÖSD-Zertifikat and German Abitur; only for technical specialised language courses) can apply for a DAAD HSK scholarship. The programme funds attendance of the German-taught HSK courses which are offered by state or state-recognised German universities and by affiliated language schools: [HSK-Kursliste](#)

Some of the eligibility criteria for students from India, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh **at the time of application**:

- Students pursuing 3-year Bachelor's degree, enrolled in the 2nd year
- Students pursuing 4-year Bachelor's degree, enrolled in the 2nd or 3rd year
- Students pursuing 2-year Master's degree, enrolled in the 1st year
- Students pursuing 5-year Master's degree (also integrated), enrolled in the 2nd, 3rd or 4th year
- **Bachelor students must have completed at least two academic years at the start of the scholarship period**
- **Students enrolled in the Final Year of Bachelor's or Master's degree programme are not eligible to apply**

Exceptional cases due to Covid-19 pandemic: In case your academic semester started late at your home university/institution, and you are unable to fulfil above-mentioned eligibility criteria, please ensure that you are enrolled at your university - both at the time of application and during the entire scholarship period. The same shall be confirmed by your home university on an official Bonafide certificate (start and end of academic semester and year).

- There must be two years between two grants for a DAAD University Summer Course.

Application Process: Online application is through DAAD portal. For Indian applicants, "Application Summary" generated on the portal must be sent to the DAAD New Delhi office. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Application Portal will open: From September 30, 2021 – December 1, 2021
